May Our Lady of Good Counsel continue to bless us all, Daisy Mah, Victoria Diocesan President.

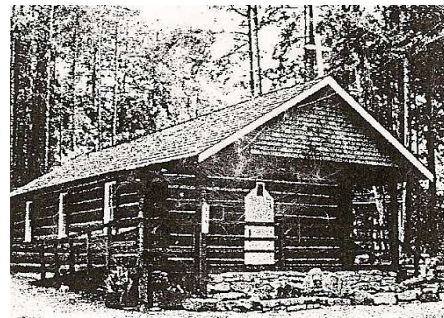
### ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SWEATER CAMPAIGN:

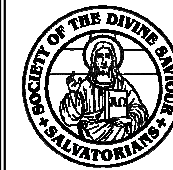
