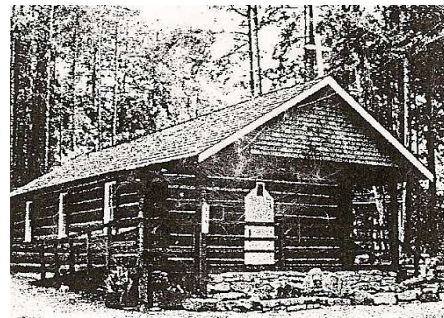
**ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SWEATER CAMPAIGN:**

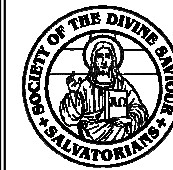

### **PHASE ONE OF THE EXTERIOR CHURCH REPAIRS TO BEGIN:**

We have received permission from the Diocese to begin phase 1 of our exterior repairs. Phase one will include the complete repair of the bell tower, the patching of other severely deteriorated areas of the exterior, the installation of upgraded rain gutters and the installation of snow stops on the roof. If you are wondering why it is necessary to upgrade our rain gutters and install snow stops....the rain gutters are currently sized for what you would find on a residential house, with the size of the Church, the amount of water coming off the roof when it rains, the gutters are not large enough to accommodate that much water, as can be seen when it rains and the gutters overflow. The snow stops are necessary to break up the snow as it slides off the roof. Currently the snow comes down in huge sheets, causing damage to the gutters and a very real danger to anyone walking too close to the building. This first phase will begin in the next couple of weeks and will be completed in approximately three months. The total cost of the phase one repairs is \$130,000.00. We will be starting a major fundraising campaign in the fall, these donations will help us to raise the money need to complete all the remaining exterior repairs. In the meantime there are a couple of ways you can help to fund the repairs. The gift card, grocery card program helps to raise funds for the Church and only costs you what you would normally pay out in groceries or expenses at other stores. Currently with the support of only 30 parishioners this program has raised over \$20,000. Imagine what we could do with 100 parishioners participating. As well donations can be made directly to the Building Fund through the blue envelopes in the pews. Be sure to put your name on the envelope so that we can issue you a tax receipt at year end. Once we receive the schedule of work from our contractor we will have poster up in the vestibule so that parishioners will be able to track the work and its completion.
